• Tuesday-Friday, September 6-9: Intake Meetings with new and returning students and families.

Students/Families will be contacted to set a time to have the intake meeting with Walker staff. During this interview, students/families will get to meet our staff, receive feedback on our program, set goals for their learning plan, talk about opportunities for community programs, etc

• Monday, September 12: First full day of school for all students.

As we get back into the swing of things, staff at WDC pride themselves on building individualized learning programs for our students. We provide students with paper based course work or online learning options. Our low staff to student ratio means we can provide a higher level of support to our students. In addition to this, students will have access to community programs such as First Aid, Foodsafe, and other types of job readiness training.
